

K-18 Softball and Baseball Association Zoom Meeting on 05/01/2020 7:00 PM to 7:43 PM

Present on the K-18 Zoom Meeting were Dave Urban, Ron Haag, Gary Frederking, Rudy Perez, John Walz and Pete Falcon

Commissioner's discussed how to proceed with a possible season this summer due to the COVID-19 nationwide shutdown. Governor Kelly has put in place a four Phase plan to reopen the State of Kansas.

In Phase #2 May 19<sup>th</sup>-June 1<sup>st</sup> Organized sports are open with 30 people in the gatherings. 6 feet social distancing.

In Phase #3 June 2<sup>nd</sup>-June 15<sup>th</sup> Organized sports are open with 90 people in the gatherings. 6 feet social distancing.

In Phase #4 June 16<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup> TBD

Each County plan may be more restrictive. Teams will need to contact their local health nurse to see if their county is following Governor Kelly's reopening plan or have implemented a more restrictive plan.

K-18 Softball and Baseball Commissioner's discussed the following:

Commissioner's agreed that we would be following Governor Kelly's recommendations with our playing season timeline which could change at any time due to circumstances.

We are wanting to provide a partial season for girls and boys this summer. We understand that some communities may not want to participate this summer due to the COVID-19 pandemic and we understand their decision. For those communities that do want to participate we have decided to follow the following timeline.

Following the Governor's Phase #2 guidelines teams could start practicing May 19<sup>th</sup> and after.

The K-18 Softball and Baseball seasons would start on June 16<sup>th</sup>.

The Regional Tournament dates for baseball will stay the same. The west and east regionals will be held the week of July 13<sup>th</sup>. The girls may not have a regional tournament, they will probably place teams at the state tournament by league standings.

The state tournament dates would stay the same. Girls Softball would be held July 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>. Boys baseball would be held July 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>.

We will need to know which communities plan on having a team this summer so schedules can be completed.
