

3.04 Official Games

An official regular season game counting toward league standings will be a seven inning game and the first game of the double header, unless shortened or lengthened legally: by rain, darkness, tie, etc. In case a seven inning game is suspended by the Umpire, it shall be deemed an official game if five full innings have been completed and not tied, or 4 ½ innings have been completed with the home team leading. The second game of the league double header shall be a game that does not count toward league standings. It will be a three inning game where no more than 5 runs may be scored per inning. This game allows for all players to get playing time. Pitch Count Rule 3.12 is in force.

Official K-18 Regional and State Tournament games will be 7 inning games.

In case a seven inning game is suspended by the Umpire it shall be deemed an official game if five full innings have been completed and not tied, or 4 ½ innings have been completed with the home team leading.

Run Rules will be used for all K-18 Baseball seven inning league and tournament games.

A decision must be made within thirty minutes after play has been halted as to whether or not the game will continued or be suspended to a later date.
